High School Trivia and Energy Career Chase Contests Official Rules

Eligibility: The High School Trivia and Energy Career Chase Contest(s) are open to all Michigan High School Students ("Entrants") in grades 9-12. By completing the Careers in Energy Week (CIEW) Contest form, you agree to these Contest rules (the "Official Rules"). The Contests are subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations. Void where prohibited by law.

Rules:

- The two (2) Contests promote Careers in Energy Week, October 19th – 23rd, and are open to all Michigan high school students in grades 9-12.
- You are welcome to enter only one Contest or both.
- All submissions must be made using the CIEW Contest form provided no later than 9 p.m. Sunday, October 25th. Only entries using this form will be accepted.

Contests:

- *Trivia Contest:*
 - Contestants must answer each day's question correctly to be eligible for the drawing.
 - Five (5) winners will be selected randomly from all qualifying trivia contest entries.
 - Each winner will receive:
 - (1) \$100 Amazon Gift Card
 - (1) Drone with camera
 - (1) \$250 for their attending school
- *Energy Chase Contest:*
 - Entrants must complete all the missions to earn the maximum points via the GooseChase app.
 - Once the missions are completed the Entrant will enter their team name into the CIEW contest form by Sunday, October 25th. (A team

- may consist of family members or friends, but one (1) person on the team must be a high school student in 9-12 grade)
- Five (5) winners/teams will be selected randomly from all qualifying contest entries.
 - Each winner/team will receive:
 - (1) \$100 Amazon Gift Card

How the Contests work:

- *Trivia Contest:*
 - Contest begins 6 a.m. Monday, October 19th. Each day (Monday through Friday), a question will be posted to the consortium website (www.CareersInEnergyMichigan.com). Entrants will visit that site to get the question each day. They will keep a running list of their answers throughout the week and submit one form by Sunday, October 25th by 9:00 pm.

- *Energy Career Chase Contest:*
 - Download the GooseChase App
 - Create an account
 - Search for the energy career chase game and enter the game code: **5DBK5Q**
 - Create a team name for yourself or it will default to your username
 - Enter the Password: **getintoenergy**
 - Read through the various missions and complete as instructed by uploading text responses, pictures, or videos
 - You must complete all the missions to be entered into the contest drawing

- Using the 2020 CIEW [Contest submission form](#), Entrants will submit their answers for the trivia Contest for the entire week and the energy chase information needed to enter the Contest no later than 9 p.m. Sunday, October 25th.
- Teachers are encouraged to use the daily questions as an opener, or quick activity in their class to promote energy career awareness. Entrants will need computer access to complete the daily task.
- Some questions will be open-ended and multiple responses will be accepted.
- Once the submission deadline closes, five (5) random winners will be chosen for each contest from all qualifying entries. Winners/Teams will be notified no later than Friday, October 30th, 2020 and prizes will be issued no later than November 25th, 2020.
